West Sussex Charity seeks Trustee/Directors

4SIGHT (West Sussex Association for the Blind), one of the larger charities based in West Sussex, is seeking new Trustees to join the Board. 4SIGHT is a registered charity and a company limited by guarantee. There are up to twelve trustees on the Board, and there are currently three vacancies. Commercial, legal, financial and eye health-related skills would be particularly beneficial to complement existing Trustees, and to reflect the major needs for anticipated growth in the work of the charity.

4SIGHT serves around 4,000 people with sight loss in and around West Sussex. We have 2,000 Association members, three resource centres, two hospital-based services, and provide support to anyone affected by sight loss. The charity has over 500 volunteers and also employs 25 staff, including nurses and other specialist staff who deliver a wide range of free services throughout Sussex, including 50 clubs, home contact visits, and a low vision assessment service. We work closely with health and social care and other local and national third sector organisations.

Trustees should be able to give a minimum of 4 hours per month and attend quarterly meeting, usually held in our Bognor Regis HQ. Trustee positions are unpaid, but expenses are reimbursed.

4SIGHT is committed to diversity and equal opportunity in employment and service provision. Applicants should be able to demonstrate a commitment to people affected by sight loss and the aims of the Charity, and ideally be currently resident or working in or near West Sussex.
