Main Activities/ Tasks

- Welcoming members and ensuring new people are introduced and made to feel included.
- Making and serving refreshments.
- Collecting entry fee/subs.
- Preparation of seating and tables.
- Helping with events/activities.
- Assisting with outings, helping people in/out of vehicles and guiding.
- Promote the support and services of 4Sight Vision Support.

Qualities/Experience/Skills

The passion to make a positive difference to people with sight loss would be advantageous. Having good communication skills and the ability to work part of a team and with venerable people is essential. Being friendly and self-motivated is key due to the nature of this role.
